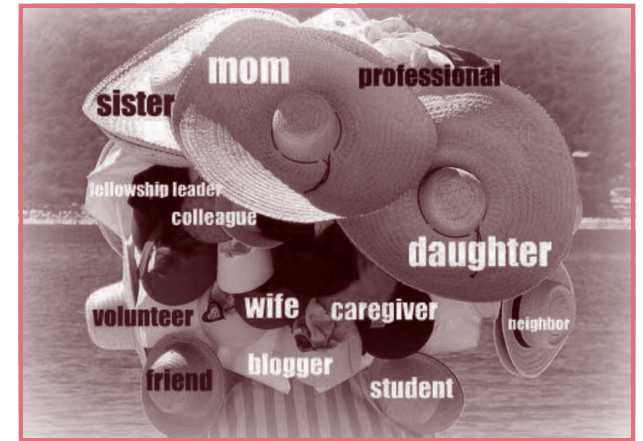

Kay Moll is a graduate of Johnson Bible College and the University of Tennessee. Her first husband, Edward Watts, was killed in an automobile accident shortly after their marriage in 1969. In 1991, Kay married Tom Moll, who is the Senior Minister of Christ's Church at Mason in Mason, Ohio. Kay is the Director of



Women's Ministries and Missions at Christ's Church at Mason. From 1998 through March 2006, she served as the Director of Vacation Bible School Ministries at Standard Publishing in Cincinnati. Kay worked from 1980 - 1991 as Director of Operations with Good News Productions, International in Joplin, Missouri. She served from 1992-1998 as the Director of Women's Ministries at Sunnybrook Christian Church in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

Kay previously served as a missionary in Zambia from 1972 through 1979- teaching Bible classes in the public school system and working with young people in the local churches.

Many of Kay's growing up years were spent on the campus of Johnson Bible College where her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Russell Morgan, served as staff members. Her three sisters, also graduates of JBC, are very actively involved in Christian ministry.

Tom's three children have become a very important part of Kay's life. All three are serving with their spouses and are planting new churches (Jim and Lori Word, Burleson, TX; Todd and René Clark, Simi Valley, CA; Brian and Allison Moll, Manhattan, NY).
